Did you know that more than 10 million children will be paralyzed in the next 40 years if the world fails to eradicate polio?

Polio is:

- A crippling and potentially fatal infectious disease, polio (poliomyelitis) still strikes children mainly under the age of five in countries in Asia, Africa, and the Middle East.
- Polio can cause paralysis and sometimes death. Because there is no cure for polio, the best protection is prevention. For as little as .60 cents worth of vaccine, a child can be protected against this crippling disease for life.
- Once infected, Polio can paralyze the victim within hours. In the most severe cases, polio attacks the motor neurons of the brain stem, causing breathing difficulty or even death.

After 20 years of hard work, Rotary and its partners such as the World Health Organization and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation are on the brink of eradicating this tenacious disease.

Although tremendous progress has been made, the world is not yet polio free. The polio virus knows no borders; it can spread from an endemic country into polio-free areas. As long as one case of polio remains in the world, no child is safe from this deadly disease.
